



The English Concentration is an option for students who wish to pursue a liberal arts degree and who have academic and career aspirations requiring a strong background in writing/language arts. It includes analysis and practice producing academic, creative, professional, and digital/multimodal writing. This concentration is appropriate for students considering careers in teaching, publishing, and writing, but also for a wide range of careers in the humanities, business, STEM, and health sciences. Upon successful completion, the Associate in Arts Degree in Liberal Arts with a concentration in English is awarded.

Graduates of the Liberal Arts: English concentration will have demonstrated the ability to:

1. Read and engage critically with a diverse range of texts and perspectives
2. Write using original thinking and voice to express a central idea, demonstrating purpose and audience awareness
3. Critically evaluate and integrate evidence to develop an argument
4. Demonstrate a collaborative, process-based approach to research, writing, and revision
5. Analyze the evolving roles that language and writing play in our identities, communities, and communications
